Overview of Services

The West Virginia State Treasurer's Office administers WVABLE, a program designed to give people with disabilities more independence and financial security.

WVABLE is made possible by the Achieving a Better Life Experience in West Virginia Act, also known as the West Virginia ABLE Act. The program allows individuals with disabilities the ability to save and invest up to \$16,000 per year without losing eligibility for public benefit programs such as Medicaid and Supplemental Security Income (SSI). Many individuals who developed a qualifying disability before the age of 26 are eligible to open an account. Earnings in a WVABLE Account grow tax-free and are not subject to federal income tax, as long as the funds are spent on Qualified Disability Expenses.
